STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for the Maine State Prison for the
3 year nineteen hundred and fifteen, to be expended for the
4 following purposes: machinery for work shop; improve-
5 ments in kitchen; repairs and new furniture for hospital;
6 repairs to houses occupied by deputy warden and chaplain;
7 repairs to repository and painting of buildings. Any por-
8 tion of said appropriation remaining unexpended at the
9 close of the year nineteen hundred and fifteen shall be avail-
10 able for the year nineteen hundred and sixteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following improvements and repairs are needed:

- 6 new winding machines for broom factory,
- 1 new hot water tank,
- Repairs on hospital and new furniture,
- 1 copper steam jack for kitchen,
- Repairs on deputy's house,
- Shingling of chaplain's house,
- Repairs on Wadsworth Street repository,
- 1 new buzz planer,
- General painting of State property.
