STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to permit the citizens of Maine to express their desires regarding constitutional provisions.

Be it cnacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whenever a petition signed by twelve thousand (12,000) 2 legal voters of Maine shall be presented to the secretary 3 of state asking that at the next regular state election the 4 voters of Maine be given an opportunity to express them-5 selves upon any desired change in the constitution of the 6 state of Maine, the ballots to be used at the state election 7 next following the presentation of such petition shall have 8 upon them the proposition for which said petition is pre-9 sented, in such form as to enable the voters to express them-10 selves for or against such proposed constitutional alteration.
