STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Rockland, South Thomaston and St. George Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the Rockland, South 2 Thomaston and St. George Railway, which were granted 3 to it by chapter 205 of the private and special laws of the 4 state of Maine for the year 1913, are hereby extended for 5 two years additional and said corporation shall have the 6 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to it by 7 said act, to be exercised by it for the same purposes as 8 specified in said act.
