STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Rockland, South Thomas-
ton and St. George Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the Rockland, South
2 Thomaston and St. George Railway, which were granted
3 to it by chapter 205 of the private and special laws of the
4 state of Maine for the year 1913, are hereby extended for
5 two years additional and said corporation shall have the
6 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to it by
7 said act, to be exercised by it for the same purposes as
8 specified in said act.
