STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 5 of Chapter 383 of the Public
Laws of 1897, relative to the Incorporation of the South
Branch Improvement Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of Chapter 383 of the Public Laws of 1897
2 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and
3 inserting in place thereof the following:

‘Sect. 5. Said corporation shall have the right to collect
5 such tolls as the county commissioners of Franklin County
6 shall decide upon, upon all lumber and pulp wood which
7 shall be floated down said stream from any point above said
8 cove, and shall have the lien upon all logs, lumber and pulp

9 wood which may be floated down said stream for the pay-
10 ment of such tolls; said lien to be enforced in the manner
11 provided for the enforcement of liens on logs and lumber,
12 by sections thirty-eight and thirty-nine of chapter ninety-
13 one of the revised statutes, and all amendments and addi-
14 tions thereto; but the logs of each particular mark shall be
15 holden only for the tolls of such mark.'
