AN ACT to Repeal Certain Obsolete Sections of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Assessment of Taxes by Parishes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The last clause of section nine of chapter sixteen of the revised statutes in the following words, "and it may be assessed and collected like state taxes," is hereby repealed, so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. Every parish, at a legal meeting, may raise money for the support of the public ministry of religion, for build-

8 ing, repairing or removing houses of public worship, and
9 for other necessary parish charges.'

Sect. 2. Section twenty-three of chapter sixteen of the
2 revised statutes is hereby repealed.
