STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT Relating to the Verification of Certificates of Organization of Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The oath to the certificate of organization of corporations 2 required by section eight of chapter forty-seven of the re-3 vised statutes may be made outside the state before a notary 4 bate: and the judge or register may appoint only one ap-5 acknowledgments of deeds in other states, by any sub-6 scriber to said certificate who was actually present in the 7 state at the meeting for the organization of the corporation. 8 All certificates heretofore verified outside the state before 9 a notary public or such commissioner shall be deemed to 10 comply with said section.
