STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 9 of Chapter 53 of the Laws of 1913, "An Act for the better regulation of the practice of Dentistry."

Be it enacted by the Pcople of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 9 of Chapter 53 of the Laws of 1913 is amended

- 2 by inserting in the sixth line the following: 'if licensed to
- 3 practice in said other state after January 1st, 1913,' so that
- 4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. The Board may at its discretion without the ex-

- 6 amination as hereinabove provided, issue its certificate to
- 7 any applicant therefor who shall furnish proof, satisfactory
- 8 to said Board that he has been duly licensed to practice

9 Dentistry in another State after full compliance with the 10 requirements of its dental laws; provided, however, that if 11 licensed to practice Dentistry in said other state after Jan12 uary 1st, 1913, his professional education shall not be less 13 than that required in this State, and provided also that such 14 applicant shall have been at least five years in actual practice in the State in which said license was granted. Every 16 certificate so given shall state on its face the grounds upon 17 which it is granted and the applicant may be required to 18 furnish proof upon affidavit. The fee for such a certificate 19 shall be Twenty Dollars.'
