STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE to provide for the payment of telephone service for members during the present session of the legislature.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated in favor of the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company the sum of five hundred dollars in payment for telephone service of members of the present legislature during its present session in accordance with the terms of the agreement made with said Company by the joint committee authorized to make an agreement with said Company for such service.
