STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Official Reporter of the Senate.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of Seven Hundred Dollars to be paid to Fred W. Lee,
3 official reporter of the Senate, for typewriting and steno-
4 graphic assistance employed by him in the preparation and
5 completion of the legislative record.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The amount specified in this resolve comprises two items, viz:

First. The sum of \$300 for services of a typewriter operator, being the same amount appropriated and paid at the last regular session of the legislature; also, the sum of \$400, authorized by arrangement with the President of the Senate, at the opening of the session, for stenographic assistance in the preparation and completion of the legislative record, and further authorized by the following order, passed in the Senate January 7th, 1915:

“Ordered, That the official reporter of the Senate be authorized to procure the services of typewriter operator, during the present session, at an expense not exceeding three hundred dollars; also, an assistant reporter, at an expense not exceeding four hundred dollars, for the preparation and completion of the legislative record.”
