RESOLVE in Favor of Indian Township for the Repair of
Roads and Bridges.

*Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) in the year
3 1917 and the sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00)
4 in the year 1918 for the repair of roads and bridges in In-
5 dian Township, in the county of Washington; said appro-
6 priation to be expended under the supervision of the state
7 highway commission.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There are about twelve (12) miles of main road in Indian Township. The principal road leads from Princeton to Waite and is a part of the main road between Calais and Houlton. A branch road leads from this road to Grand Lake Stream. All of these roads are heavily traveled by residents of the adjoining towns going to Princeton, which is the railroad outlet, and by tourist traffic during the summer season; also daily stage lines with R. F. D. These roads are both market and trunk line roads. It is up to the State to maintain these roads and up to each session of the Legislature to appropriate sufficient funds for the purpose.
