STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter three hundred and thirty-seven of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen relating to the amount to be paid for clerk hire in the Municipal Court of the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of Chapter three hundred and 2 thirty-seven of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and 3 fifteen is hereby amended by striking out the words "seven 4 hundred eighty" in the twenty-sixth line thereof and insert- 5 ing in the place thereof the words 'fourteen hundred and

6 four,' so that paragraph four of said section shall read as 7 follows:

'Cumberland county, for clerks in the office of register of 2 deeds, two thousand seven hundred dollars; for clerks in the 3 office of register of probate, two thousand one hundred 4 dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, two 5 thousand two hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of the 6 recorder of Portland municipal court, fourten hundred and 7 four dollars.'
