STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to enable Forest Hill Cemetery Association to convey its real estate and personal property to the inhabitants of Bridgton as body corporate and to dissolve said Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. That Forest Hill Cemetery Association, a cor-2 poration organized and existing under the laws of the State
3 of Maine as and for a public burying ground association
4 located at Bridgton in the county of Cumberland, is author-5 ized and empowered to give without compensation and con-6 vey by deed to the inhabitants of Bridgton as a body cor-7 porate all the right, title and interest of said association at

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8 the time of such conveyance in and to any and all real estate 9 and all money by it then owned to be held and owned by 10 said body corporate as and for a town public burying ground 11 with the right to sell and convey unsold burial lots therein 12 with such privileges and appurtenances as appertain and 13 attach to such lots.

Sect. 2. And said body corporate is authorized and em-2 powered to take and receive by deed said right, title and 3 interest of said association in said real estate and in said 4 money for the purpose and object of converting said burial 5 ground into a town public burying ground to be held, man-6 aged and controlled by said body corporate as town burial 7 grounds are required to be held, managed and controlled 8 by law.

Any action by said body corporate in the premises may be 2 taken at a meeting of the voters thereof duly called there-3 for.

Upon acceptance of said real estate and money by said body 2 corporate as aforesaid said association is hereby dissolved.

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
