STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 134 of the Special Laws of 1831 entitled "An Act Establishing a Fire Department in the Town of Portland"; Sections 1, 3 and 4 of Chapter 167 of the Special Laws of 1853 entitled "An Act Relating to the City of Portland"; Chapter 285 of the Special Laws of 1854 entitled "An Act Respecting the Erection of Wooden Buildings in the City of Portland."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 134 of the Special Laws of 1831 entitled "An Act 2 Establishing a Fire Department in the Town of Portland"

3 is hereby repealed.

Section 1, section 3 and section 4 of Chapter 167 of the
2 Special Laws of 1853 entitled, "An Act Relating to the City
3 of Portland" are hereby repealed.

Chapter 285 of the Special Laws of 1854 entitled, "An Act
2 Respecting the Erection of Wooden Buildings in the City
3 of Portland" is hereby repealed.
