STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section Forty-three of Chapter thirty-three
of the Revised Statutes (1916) relating to the use of deer in
lumber camps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-three of Chapter thirty-three of
2 the Revised Statutes (1916) is hereby amended by striking
3 out all of said section and substituting therefor the follow-
4 ing:

'Sect. 43. No deer or part thereof shall be used or had in
2 possession, by any person, at any time, in any camp, house or

3 other building used partly or wholly in lumbering operations.
4 Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to
5 a penalty of forty dollars and costs for each deer or part
6 thereof used or had in possession in violation of this
7 section.'
