STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter Thirty-three of the Revised
Statutes (1916) Relating to Fishing in Certain Tributaries
to Prestile Stream, in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch
2 or kill any kind of fish at any time in Palmer brook, or in
3 Trueworthy brook, or in Allen brook, or in Marshall brook,
4 tributaries to Prestile stream, in Aroostook county. It shall
5 also be unlawful for any person to have in possession at
6 any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any provision
7 of this act. Whoever violates any provision of this act

8 shall pay a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$30 and
9 costs for each offense, and \$1 additional for each fish taken,
10 caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any pro-
11 vision of this act.
