STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Paragraph 7, Section 98 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes of 1916, relative to by-laws of towns, cities and villages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph 7 of Section 98 of Chapter 4 of the Revised

- 2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "hy-
- 3 drant" the words 'the maintenance and operation of side-
- 4 walk tanks and pumps for the sale or distribution of gaso-
- 5 line or other volatile inflammable liquid for fuel or power,
- 6 supporting posts for any awning, marquee or other tempo-

7 rary or permanent structure over the street or sidewalk' so 8 that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'VII. Respecting the location and protection of monuments, boundary-stones, curb-stones, stepping-stones or
horse-blocks, trees, lamp-posts, posts and hydrants, the
maintenance and operation of sidewalk tanks and pumps
for the sale or distribution of gasoline or other volatile inflammable liquid for fuel or power, supporting posts for any
marquee or other temporary or permanent structure
over the street or sidewalk, and all other things placed within the limits of their roads, ways and streets, by municipal
authority and for legitimate municipal purposes; and no
such objects placed as aforesaid, if located in accordance
with such by-laws and ordinances, shall be deemed defects
in such road, way or street.'
