STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Provide for Conducting Scientific Investigation Bearing upon the Agriculture of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Maine Agricultural Experiment Station,
2 in addition to investigations now conducted by it, shall con3 duct scientific investigations bearing upon the agriculture
4 of Aroostook county for the purpose of making effective
5 section four of chapter one hundred ninety of the Private
6 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen.

Sect. 2. There shall be appropriated from the state treas-2 ury the sum of five thousand dollars for the year nineteen 3 hundred seventeen and the sum of five thousand dollars for 4 the year nineteen hundred eighteen in favor of the Maine 5 Agricultural Experiment Station, and the same shall be 6 expended by the director of said station in executing the 7 provisions of this act. The payment of said appropriation 8 shall be made quarterly, in advance, on the order of the 9 governor and council, who shall draw warrants for that 10 purpose, and a statement of the disbursement of the funds 11 above appropriated, in detail so far as practicable, shall be 12 filed annually with the state auditor.
