STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the city of Portland to pension Dora B. McIntosh, widow of Charles E. McIntosh, police officer of said city, shot in the performance of duty.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The City Council of the city of Portland may annually
2 hereafter appropriate and pay to Dora B. McIntosh,
3 widow of Charles E. McIntosh, a special officer performing
4 regular duty in the police department of the city of Portland,
5 who on the fifteenth day of December, 1915, lost his life in
6 the performance of official duty, a sum not exceeding
7 twenty-five dollars per month so long as she remains a
8 widow, resident of the city of Portland and in need of said
9 annuity for her support.
