STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT authorizing Stanley Burrill and Frank W. Mallett, of Fort Kent, County of Aroostook, and Maurice O. Brown of Dover, County of Piscataquis, to erect and maintain piers, piles and booms in the Allagash River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Stanley Burrill, Frank W. Mallett and
2 Maurice O. Brown, their heirs and assigns, are hereby
3 authorized and empowered to locate, erect and maintain
4 piers, piles and booms in the Allagash River in Township
5 Fifteen, Range Eleven, contiguous to land now owned by

6 them in said township Fifteen, range Eleven, for the pur-
 7 pose of holding all logs and other lumber coming down said
 8 stream and destined for use of manufacture by them.

Sect. 2. Said piers, piles and booms shall be so con-
 2 structed that logs, pulpwood and other lumber shall not be
 3 impeded or delayed in its passage down said river, and
 4 expense of such delay, if any, shall be paid by parties own-
 5 ing and operating said piers and booms.

Sect. 3. All other logs and lumber than those provided
 3 for by section one held by, or found in said booms, shall
 4 be turned out thereof by them and at their own expense.
