STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT authorizing the maintenance of a bridge between the mill and store house, by Worumbo Manufacturing Company, Lisbon Falls, Maine.

Be it enacted by the Pcople of the State of Maine, as follows: That the Worumbo Manufacturing Company, its suc-2 cessors and assigns, be hereby authorized to maintain a 3 bridge of steel and iron, as now located and constructed,
4 from its mill proper, located at Lisbon Falls, in Lisbon,
5 Maine, over and across Canal Street to its store house, or
6 store houses, located Northerly and across said Canal street,
7 from said mill; said bridge to be nine (9) feet in width, to 8 have a clearance of not less than sixteen (16) feet above 9 the surface of said Canal Street, with piers wholly outside 10 the traveled way of said street as now located, and to be 11 approximately one hundred and sixty-five (165) feet East-12 erly of the Easterly side of the bridge connecting Main 13 Street, so called, with the mill proper; and said bridge so 14 constructed and maintained shall not be considered an in-15 cumbrance or nuisance in said street, and neither the town 16 of Lisbon, the County of Androscoggin, nor the Worumbo 17 Manufacturing Company shall be liable for any damage 18 occasioned thereby.
