AN ACT to authorize Allan E. Hammond and his associates to erect piers and maintain booms in the St. John river in Hamlin plantation.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Allan E. Hammond of Van Buren, Chester C. Whitney of  
2 Boston, Mass., Frank L. Perry of Woburn, Mass., and  
3 Henry K. Hyde of Ware, Mass., their associates, successors,  
4 and assigns are hereby authorized to build piers and main-  
5 tain booms in the Saint John river, in Hamlin plantation,  
6 from a point opposite the upper or northwesterly line of lot  
7 numbered three hundred and seventeen, to a point opposite

8 the lower or southeasterly line of lot numbered three hun-  
9 dred and forty-five, for the purpose of holding lumber for  
10 purposes of manufacture, but not so as to interfere with the  
11 free navigation of the river.
