AN ACT to authorize guardians of insane widows to waive  
the provisions of their husband's wills.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

A guardian of an insane person shall have the same right  
2 that his ward would have if sane to waive the provisions  
3 of a will in favor of his ward and to take for his ward's  
4 use the same property and rights that such ward would  
5 have if sane, with the same right to extension of time within  
6 which such waiver may be filed, and all other rights set out  
7 in Sections 13 and 14 of Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes.
