STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section twelve, chapter one hundred eighty-one, Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relating to prisoners escaping from county farm.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twelve, chapter one hundred eighty-one of the
2 laws of nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby amended by
3 adding thereto the words: 'or he may be sentenced to the
4 county jail for a term not exceeding one year,' so that said
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 12. If a prisoner serving sentence at the county

2 farm escapes or attempts to escape or goes away from said
3 farm without permission he shall when recaptured be re-
4 turned, subject to such rules and regulations as said county
5 commissioners and superintendent shall deem necessary to
6 keep him at the farm, or he may be sentenced to the county
7 jail for a term not exceeding one year.'
