STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to prevent officers and employes of life and fire insurance institutions from making copies of records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any officer or employe of any fire or life insurance company, whether stock, mutual or otherwise, making copies of any of the books, papers, records or documents belonging to or in the custody of any of the before named institutions, either for his own use or for the use of any other person, other than in the ordinary and regular course of his duties as such officer or employe, shall be subject to a penalty of a

8 fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, or by imprisonment
9 not exceeding one year or by both such fine and imprison-
