STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT entitled An Act to compel the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company to give rates to certain newspapers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company
2 shall allow to all Associated Press newspapers the same
3 rate of discount on tolls from Augusta and other cities and
4 towns in this state as is allowed by the Western Union
5 Telegraph Company and the Postal Telegraph Cable Com-
6 pany.
