# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 99 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, relating to the office of corporation counsel for the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 99 of the Private and Special Laws

- 2 of nineteen hundred and fifteen, abolishing the office of city
- 3 solicitor of the city of Portland, and creating the office of
- 4 corporation counsel for the city of Portland, and determin-
- 5 ing his duties, tenure of office, and salary, is hereby re-
- 6 pealed.

- Upon this act taking effect, the mayor of the city 2 of Portland shall, with the approval of the aldermen, ap-3 point a city solicitor for the city of Portland to hold office 4 until the second Monday of December next following, and 5 thereafter his successors in office shall be appointed annually 6 by the mayor with the approval of the aldermen; provided, 7 however, that any city solicitor may be removed from office 8 for inefficiency by the mayor, with the approval of the aldero men, after a hearing before the mayor and aldermen. No 10 person shall be appointed to said office who shall not have II been admitted as an attorney and counselor of the courts of 12 this state, and have been in the active practice of law for at 13 least three years. Should any vacancy occur in the office of 14 city solicitor before the expiration of a term, the mayor may, 15 with the approval of the aldermen, fill said vacancy for the 16 unexpired portion of said term. Each city solicitor shall 17 hold office until his successor shall have been appointed and 18 qualified.
  - Sect. 3. The duties and salary of the city solicitor shall 2 be fixed and determined by the city council of the city of 3 Portland by ordinance.
