STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one hundred three of Chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes relating to state aid for academies having income from invested funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred three of Chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words
2 "one thousand" in the sixth line thereof and substituting in
3 place thereof the words 'one thousand five hundred' so that
4 said section when amended shall read as follows:
5

'Sect. 103. No academy shall receive state aid under section
2 ninety-eight if said academy has an annual income from

3 invested funds exceeding two thousand dollars; and no
4 academy shall receive state aid to exceed five hundred dol-
5 lars in any given year provided the said academy has an
6 annual income from invested funds exceeding one thousand
7 five hundred dollars; provided, however, that any academy
8 with a larger average attendance than two hundred shall
9 receive such aid not to exceed one thousand dollars if its
10 annual income from invested funds, after deducting interest
11 paid on its indebtedness, does not exceed two thousand
12 dollars.'
