IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to the Knox Gas and Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The action of the Knox Gas and Electric Company, a corporation organized under the provisions of Chapter three hundred fifty-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-three in purchasing the capital stock, franchises, property, rights, privileges and immunities of the Rockland and Thomaston Gas Light Company, the Camden and Rockport Electric Light Company, and the Thomaston and Warren Electric Light and Power Company as provided in said act, is hereby ratified, confirmed, ap-

10 proved and declared legal and valid; and the Knox Gas and
11 Electric Company which has succeeded to the locations,
12 powers, privileges, rights, immunities, franchises, property
13 and liabilities of said several corporations, shall have, hold,
14 possess, exercise and enjoy in its own name said locations,
15 powers, privileges, rights, immunities, franchises and prop-
16 erty of said several corporations as though originally granted
17 to it.
