### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to the Rockland, Thomaston and Camden Street Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The action of the Rockland, Thomaston and
2 Camden Street Railway, a corporation organized under the
3 provisions of Chapter one hundred ninety-three of the
4 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-one,
5 and as amended by Chapter two hundred twelve of the
6 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred one, in pur7 chasing the property, capital stock, rights, privileges, im-

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8 munities and franchises of the Knox Gas and Electric Com9 pany as provided in said amended act, is hereby ratified, con10 firmed, approved and declared legal and valid; and the
11 Rockland, Thomaston and Camden Street Railway which
12 has succeeded to the locations, powers, privileges, rights, im13 munities, franchises, property and liabilities of said Knox
14 Gas and Electric Company shall have, hold, possess, exercise
15 and enjoy in its own name said locations, powers, privileges,
16 rights, immunities, franchises and property of said Knox
17 Gas and Electric Company as though originally granted to it.
Sect. 2. The location of the poles, wires and fixtures of
2 the said Rockland, Thomaston and Camden Street Railway
3 as now established and maintained in Camden, Rockport,

4 Rockland, Thomaston, South Thomaston and Warren are 5 confirmed and made valid
