STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter eighty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Gardiner Water District," as amended by Chapter eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred five.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of said Chapter eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, is hereby amended by leaving out the word "March" and inserting the word 'January' in its stead. Also leaving out the words "December thirty-first" and inserting in their

6 stead, the words, 'June thirtieth.' Also adding after the
7 words "water district" in Section two, the words, 'so as to
8 conform to the date fixed by the Public Utilities Commis-
9 sion for its return,' so that said section as amended shall read
10 as follows:

'Sect. 2. The trustees of said Gardiner Water District
2 shall, on or before January first of each year, make and file
3 with the municipal officers of the city of Gardiner, a report
4 of their doings as trustees of said water district, and a
5 statement of the receipts and disbursements of said water
6 district, during the year ending June thirtieth next preced-
7 ing, and this shall be deemed the fiscal year of said water
8 district, so as to conform to the date fixed by the Public
9 Utilities Commission for its return.'
