STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to Vassalboro, China and Windsor Light
and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Vassalboro, China, and Windsor Light
2 and Power Company, a corporation organized under the
3 general laws of the State of Maine, is hereby authorized to
4 make, generate, sell and distribute, and supply gas and elec-
5 tricity for lighting, heating, manufacturing and mechanical
6 purposes in the town of Albion, and in that part of the
7 town of Vassalboro situated south of the Meadow Brook
8 road, so-called, and east of a line beginning at a point on

9 said Meadow Brook road one mile east of the Kennebec
10 river and extending southerly to a point in the south line
11 of the town of Vassalboro one mile east of the Kennebec
12 river.

Sect. 2. The various powers and privileges conferred on
2 said Vassalboro, China, and Windsor Light and Power
3 Company by this act shall be construed in furtherance and
4 not in limitation of the powers and privileges conferred on
5 said corporation by the general law.

Sect. 3. The various powers and privileges acquired by
2 the said Vassalboro, China, and Windsor Light and Power
3 Company by reason of its charter under the general law, are
4 hereby revived, and all acts of said company done in accord-
5 ance with its charter rights are hereby declared legal and
6 valid.
