STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 171 of the Private and Special Laws of 1879 entitled "An Act amendatory to an amended Act incorporating the Kennebec Log Driving Company," approved March 5, 1869.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section One of Chapter 171 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1879 is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the word "charter" in the third line of said section the
4 following: 'immediately after the close of the drive on Dead
5 River and' and by inserting after the word "anticipation" in
6 the fourth line of said paragraph the following: 'in either

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7 of said assessments,' so that said section as amended shall 8 read as follows:

'Section I. The directors of said Kennebec log driving 2 company are hereby authorized to assess the tax for driv-3 ing logs, contemplated in said charter, immediately after 4 the close of the drive on Dead River and immediately after 5 the close of the drive on the East Branch, so called, and in 6 anticipation in either of said assessments of the actual cost 7 of driving on the Main river, so called. And if after said 8 logs and other timber shall have been driven and all ex-9 penses ascertained and estimated, it shall be found that said 10 assessment shall be more than sufficient to pay said ex-11 penses, then the balance so remaining shall be by the di-12 rectors refunded to said owner or owners, in proportion to 13 said sum to them respectively assessed.'

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
