STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 191 of the Private and Special Laws of 1913, and authorizing the County of Penobscot to borrow money for the purpose specified in said act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 191 of the Private and Special Laws of 1913 is hereby amended by adding thereto as follows:

‘Sect. 13. For the purpose of acquiring the necessary lands and building and equipping the necessary buildings thereon, as aforesaid, the county commissioners of said county of Penobscot are hereby authorized to procure by loan on the

5 faith and credit of said county, a sum of money not exceed-
6 ing twenty thousand dollars; and for that purpose bonds or
7 obligations of said county, signed by said county commis-
8 sioners, and countersigned by the county treasurer, shall be
9 issued with interest-bearing coupons attached for the pay-
10 ment thereof at such times and with such rates of interest
11 as they shall deem expedient.'
