STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter 5, Revised Statutes, imposing an added duty on boards of registration and municipal officers acting as a board of registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The following section is hereby added to Chapter 5, Revised
2 Statutes:

'Sect. 47. Whenever an applicant for registration, before
2 any board of registration or the municipal officers of any
3 town acting as a board of registration, states his last voting
4 place as a city or town in the state of Maine, and said board

5 determines that said applicant is entitled to register, it shall
6 immediately notify by mail the board of the city or town,
7 where such person last voted, of such registration, and said
8 board receiving such notice shall forthwith strike said appli-
9 cant's name from its list.
