STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to complete the records in Hancock County Registry of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Sect. I. The county commissioners of Hancock county are
2 hereby authorized and empowered to procure some suitable
3 person to make copies and indexes, in proper volumes to be
4 furnished by the county commissioners of said county, for
5 preservation in the Hancock County Registry of Deeds, of
6 all records pertaining to titles of land now embraced in the
7 present limits of Hancock county, and now in the registry of

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8 deeds in the county of Lincoln, and of the certificates of the 9 records thereof.

Sect. 2. The copy of each deed or instrument made under 2 the authority of this act and of the certificate of the record 3 thereof, shall be attested by the person employed by the 4 county commissioners by authority of section one of this act, 5 as a true copy from the Lincoln county records of deeds, in 6 the Hancock registry, and copies of the record of such copies 7 and certificates shall be admissible in evidence in all cases 8 where copies of the original records would be admissible.

Sect. 3. For the copy of such records, excepting the marg-2 inal notes of the discharge of mortgages which notes shall 3 be included in the original mortgage as one copy, and the 4 proper indexing of the same, said person employed by the 5 county commissioners by authority of section one of this act 6 shall receive therefor sixty cents, for each deed or instru-7 ment, to be paid out of the treasury of said county of Han-8 cock, as soon as completed.
