STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to revive and extend the charter of the Penobscot
Bay Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter three hundred and fifteen of the private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, entitled, "An Act to Incorporate the Penobscot Bay Water Company," as amended by Chapter two hundred and fifty-five of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, is hereby revived and extended to July one, nineteen hundred and nineteen.

Sect. 2. William T. Haines and John J. Moore are
2 authorized to organize said corporation.
