STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to Section twenty-nine
of Chapter fifty of the Revised Statutes of Maine for nineteen
hundred sixteen, entitled "The Workmen's Compensation
Act."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-nine of Chapter fifty of the Revised Statutes
2 of nineteen hundred sixteen is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph to said section:

"The commission is further empowered to employ an inves-

2 tigator, when necessary, or to delegate the secretary to make
3 investigation in disputed cases for the purpose of adjusting
4 the same. From and after July first nineteen, hundred seven-
5 teen, there shall be appropriated a sufficient amount for
6 clerical and other assistance, traveling expenses, physicians'
7 and witness' fees and all other necessary expenses.'
