STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to repeal Chapter four hundred and fifty-three of the Private and Special Laws of the year of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and all acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof, relating to a ferry across the Penobscot river, between the town of Orono and the town of Bradley.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter four hundred and fifty-three of the Private and
3 Special Laws of the year of eighteen hundred and sixty-
4 eight, and all acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof,
5 particularly including Chapter one hundred and thirty of the

6 Private and Special Laws of the year of nineteen hundred
7 and seven, under and by virtue of the provisions of which
8 legislation Ulysses H. Walker, of Orono, maintains and
9 operates a ferry across the Penobscot river, to and fro be-
10 tween the town of Orono and the town of Bradley, are
11 hereby repealed.
