STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize Lewiston, Augusta and Waterville Street
Railway to discontinue its present tracks on State street in
Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Lewiston, Augusta and Waterville Street Railway is hereby
2 authorized to abandon the operation of that part of its road
3 located on State street in Augusta which extends northerly
4 from the intersection of Western avenue with said State
5 street; and to take up and remove the rails, ties, switches,
6 poles, wires and all other fixtures of said part of its said

7 road; and after said abandonment neither said corporation
8 nor its successors nor assigns shall be under any obligation to
9 maintain and operate said portion of its road.
