STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to incorporate Gould Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. N. M. Jones, W. S. Davidson, A. R. Gould, E. R.

- 2 Teed, R. H. McDonald, L. E. Gould and H. T. Powers, their
- 3 associates, successors and assigns, are hereby made a body
- 4 corporate by the name of Gould Electric Company.

Sect. 2. The purposes of said corporation shall be to

- 2 make, generate, buy, sell, distribute and supply electricity for
- 3 all purposes, in the county of Aroostook, in accordance with
- 4 the general statutes of the state of Maine relating to that
- 5 business.

- Sect. 3. The said corporation is hereby authorized to con-2 struct lines for the transmission of electricity upon and 3 along highways and public roads in said county of Aroostook 4 when necessary to carry into effect the purposes of this act.
- Sect. 4. The capital stock of said corporation shall not ex2 ceed one million dollars, a part of which may be preferred
 3 stock, the amount to be fixed from time to time by the stock4 holders of said corporation. The said corporation may issue
 5 bonds, which may be secured by mortgages of its property
 6 and franchises. All issues of stocks and bonds shall be sub7 ject to the provisions of Section 37, Chapter 55 of the
 8 Revised Statutes of Maine.
- Sect. 5. The said corporation is hereby authorized, with 2 the approval of the Public Utilities Commission of Maine, to 3 purchase or lease all property of every kind and description, 4 including franchises of the Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Limited, located in the state of 6 Maine, including all rights heretofore granted to the said 7 Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Lim-8 ited, by the Legislature of the state of Maine, and upon such 9 purchase or lease the said Gould Electric Company, its successors and assigns, shall have, hold, possess, exercise and 11 enjoy all the locations, powers, privileges, rights, immunities, 12 franchises, property and assets which at the time of such 13 transfer shall then be held, possessed or enjoyed by the said 14 Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Limited, within the state of Maine. After such purchase or lease

16 the said Gould Electric Company shall be subject to all liabil-17 ities to which the said Maine and New Brunswick Electrical 18 Power Company, Limited, shall then be subject by reason of 19 any contract to be performed within the state of Maine.

Sect. 6. The Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power 2 Company, Limited, is hereby authorized, with the approval 3 of the Public Utilities Commission of Maine, to sell or lease 4 to the said Gould Electric Company all its property of every 5 kind and description located within the State of Maine, in-6 cluding all rights heretofore granted to it by the Legislature 7 of the state of Maine, and upon such sale or lease all rights 8 of the said Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power 9 Company, Limited, to transact business in the state of Maine 10 as a public utility shall terminate, excepting that said Maine 11 and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Limited, 12 may sell electric current to said Gould company.

- Sect. 7. The said Gould Electric Company is hereby 2 authorized, with the approval of the Public Utilities Commis-3 sion of Maine, to acquire by purchase plants, property, fran-4 chises, rights, privileges and locations of other corporations 5 or individuals engaged in the electric business in the said 6 county of Aroostook and also to purchase stocks, bonds or 7 other securities of such corporations.
- Sect. 8. Upon the organization of the said Gould Electric 2 Company it shall be subject to all the liabilities to which 3 electric companies organized under the general law are sub-4 ject, and shall have and possess all the rights and privileges 5 of such companies.
