STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to fix the salaries of the chairman and secretary of the
Industrial Accident Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The chairman of the Industrial Accident Com-
2 mission shall receive an annual salary of four thousand
3 dollars, which said salary shall be paid in equal monthly
4 payments.

Sect. 2. The secretary of the Industrial Accident Commis-
2 sion shall receive an annual salary of twenty-five hundred
3 dollars, which said salary shall be paid in equal monthly
4 payments.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the
2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
