STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE providing for the completion of the Book of Plans of Waldo County and appropriating money therefor.

Resolved. That the State Land Agent be, and hereby is, 2 instructed to cause the Book of Plans for Waldo county 3 to be completed by adding to the plans already in said book 4 such plans by the Massachusetts archives as have not also ready been copied, and by having all copies certified by the 6 Secretary of State for Massachusetts, after which said book 7 shall be forwarded to the Register of Deeds for said county 8 of Waldo, and the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars,

9 or such part of that sum as may be necessary, hereby is 10 appropriated to pay the expense of such completion.

STATEMENTS OF FACTS.

Some twenty-five years ago or more a start was made at copying all plans of Maine lands in the Massachusetts archives and most of the work was done, the plan being to have two copies made of each plan, one for the Land Office and one for the Register of Deeds in which the land is situated. The work was mostly done and most of the counties, especially the large counties received their copies years ago, while the book for Waldo county is still incomplete.
