STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 4 of Chapter 8, Revised Statutes of 1916, relatives to Duties of State Assessors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 4 of Chapter 8, Revised Statutes, is amended by
2 the addition of the following sentence after the first sentence
3 thereof:

In apportioning the State Taxes among the several Cities 2 and Towns, of the State, such apportionment shall be upon 3 the last annual return of the Assessors of Cities and Towns. So that as amended said section shall read:

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Sect. 4. The board of state assessors shall constitute 2 a state board of equalization, whose duty it shall be to 3 equalize the state and county taxes among the several towns 4 and unorganized townships in the manner hereinafter pro-5 vided, and to apportion the state taxes among the several 6 towns of the state. In apportioning the State Taxes among 7 the several cities and towns of the State, such apportion-8 ment shall be upon the last annual return of the Assessors 9 of Cities and Towns. They shall exercise and perform such 10 other powers and duties as may be required or imposed upon 11 them by law.'
