STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to Librarians receiving Instruction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eighty-two of Chapter four of the Revised Statutes
2 is hereby amended by inserting before the word "The" in
3 the second line thereof the words 'On application to the
4 state librarian or the Maine Library Commission,' and by
5 inserting after the words "state library" in the third line
6 thereof, the words 'or at their own library,' so that said
7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 82. On application to the state librarian or the
2 Maine Library Commission, the librarian or trustees of any

3 free public library may receive instruction at the state library
 4 or at their own library, in cataloguing, and any other mat-
 5 ters pertaining to the maintenance or administration of the
 6 library.
