STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section Seventy-five of Chapter Four of
the Revised Statutes relating to Free Public Libraries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-five of Chapter four of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out, after the word
3 "therefrom" in the fifth line thereof, the words "for the
4 foundation and commencement of such library, a sum not
5 exceeding two dollars and," so that said section as amended
6 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 75. Any village corporation located in a town
2 where no free library exists, may establish a library within
3 its limits for the free use of all its inhabitants; and may

4 levy and assess a corporate tax and appropriate therefrom
5 for its maintenance and increase annually a sum not ex-
6 ceeding one dollar for each ratable poll within the limits
7 of such village corporation in the year next preceding. Vil-
8 lage libraries established under this section shall be subject
9 to all the duties and entitled to all the privileges prescribed
10 by the laws relating to free public libraries in towns.'
