STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE. HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one hundred of Chapter fifty-twoof the Revised Statutes, relating to loan and building associations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That the word "one" in the second line of said section be 2 stricken out and that the word 'two' be inserted in place

3 thereof, so that said section, so amended, shall read as fol-

4 lows:

'Sect. 100. Capital Stock; shares may be issued in series.

2 R. S. c. 48, §56.

The capital to be accumulated shall not exceed two mil-2 lion dollars, and shall be divided into shares of the ultimate

- 3 value of two hundred dollars each. The shares may be
- 4 issued in quarterly, half yearly or yearly series, in such
- 5 amounts and at such times as the members may determine.
- 6 No person shall hold more than twenty-five shares in the
- 7 capital of any such association. No shares of a prior series
- 8 shall be issued after the issue of a new series.'
