STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to repeal so much of Section Fifty-nine of Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of Maine as amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen and as amended by Section Sixteen of Chapter Two Hundred Seventy-seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen relative to Traps and Snares Set for Fur-Bearing Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of said section fifty-nine, as amended, and which
2 reads as follows: 'No person shall at any time set a snare
3 for any fur-bearing animal, nor shall any person at any time

4 set any trap or traps of any kind for any wild animal with-
5 out having the trap or traps plainly labeled with his full
6 name and address, either by having the same stamped on
7 the trap or on a metal tag, firmly attached to the trap.
8 Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay
9 a fine of five dollars and costs for each offense and in addi-
10 tion thereto five dollars for each trap set and not marked
11 as provided herein, and shall forfeit the trap or traps, and
12 any wild animal found therein, to any person finding the
13 same.' be repealed.
