STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter eighty-three, Section five of the Revised Statutes, relative to the time and place of holding the County Commissioners Court in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter eighty-three of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the entire paragraph of said section relating to the holding of county commissioners courts in York county, and substituting therefor the following paragraph so that said paragraph of said section when amended shall read as follows:

‘York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of April and

2 October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held on the
3 first Tuesday of each month, January at Saco, all other
4 months at Alfred.'
