STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 141 of the Private and Special Laws of 1887, entitled, An Act to amend an Act creating the Phillips Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. "Section 1" of Section 1, of Chapter 141 of
2 the Private and Special Laws of 1887 is hereby amended
3 by changing the territory embraced within the limits of
4 Phillips Village Corporation so as to exclude four acres
5 and the buildings thereon now owned by Abbie M. Warren
6 and two pieces or parcels of land with the buildings thereon

7 now owned by Lucien H. Warren, one piece of one-half acre
8 and the other piece of two acres.

Sect. 2. Said premises now owned by Abbie M. Warren
2 and Lucien H. Warren are hereby set out, off and from
3 said Phillips Village Corporation and none of the provisions
4 contained in Chapter 141 of the Private Laws of 1887 shall
5 apply to said territory.
